26 Things You Need to Know





Campfires Motorized Vehicles



Campfires are allowed 7:00 am to 11:30 pm. Fires must be completely extinguished with water (no flames or hot coals) by 11:30 pm. Fires are only permitted in campground provided fire rings. Any type of open unit (i.e. solo stoves) fueled by propane is not allowed. Campfires must never be left unattended. Flames should be no higher than 24" above the rim and wood must be contained within the perimeter of the fire ring.



Visitors

All day and overnight visitors must be registered at the office upon arrival and are not allowed to bring boats, golf carts, or pets. Day guests must leave the park by 8:00 pm. The occupant of the site is responsible for the behavior of all guests.

Golf Carts



Only 1 golf cart will be permitted per site. Golf carts designed for use on grass/turf only (golf carts designed for off road use, other cart variations, ATV's, UTV's, etc. are not allowed). Golf carts must be registered with the campground at check in (\$). Golf carts must have an operating headlight and taillight, and a valid certificate of insurance before being permitted to operate. All golf cart operators must read and follow the guidelines on the golf cart registration form. Golf cart use is only allowed on campground property except when dumping, and must add and must not be taken off road on wooded trails or be driven on town roads including Shawtown Rd. Only Bluffs seasonal campers and their guests (who are 21 or older) may operate a golf cart in the Bluffs.

Privately Owned Golf Carts: Restricted to licensed drivers 19 years and older.

Rental Golf Carts: Restricted to 2 licensed drivers 21 years and older.



Bike riding after dark is not permitted. NH Law requires helmet use for children under the age of 16, but we strongly encourage helmet use by everyone. Park bicycles in bike racks. Do not block doorways or walkways to buildings. Bike tags will be given at check in and must be displayed on bike throughout reservation. Bicyclists must obey all traffic signs and ride responsibly.

Only 2 vehicles are permitted per site and may not park on the side of the road or in the wood line. Additional vehicles may be registered for \$5/day or \$25/week and will be required to park in the overflow parking. Motorized vehicles allowed are trucks, cars motorcycles, and golf carts. They must be registered with the office at check in and must always display a car pass on the rearview mirror. No means of transportation may be operated at night without proper lighting.

Etiquette

As a family campground, guests are expected to be respectful and courteous to others. Any type of bullying, aggressive behavior or actions deemed inappropriate by management, towards any guest(s) or member of the resort team, will result in removal from the park, and forfeiture of the site without refund. Profanity will not be tolerated. Repeat offender will be asked to leave

Quiet Time ,z

Ouiet time is from 11:00 pm to 7:00 am. Children under 18 must be on their registered site by 11:00 pm unless accompanied by an adult. Loud, objectionable noise, amplified music, and karaoke are not allowed at any time.



Utilities

Campers staying in any type of camping RV with holding tanks, must keep valves closed at all times. waste digester to the start of every new tank. It is illegal to dump gray water on the ground. Dispose of gray and black water through the sewer hookup on your site or at the nearest dump station.



Alcohol

New Hampshire's drinking age is 21. Underage drinking, use of drugs, excessive use of alcohol, or any other illegal activities will result in immediate removal by local authorities. Intoxicated, loud, and/or obnoxious behaviors are not permitted. NEVER leave alcohol where it is accessible to others. No type of outside bar, such as a tiki bar, is allowed.



Playgrounds are located in Danforth Bay only. Hours are from 8:30 am until sunset. Children should not be left unattended.

Motorized Boats

Any type of jet powered watercraft is not allowed. Motorboats larger than 21' are not permitted. Only one boat per site, and boats must be registered at the office at check-in (\$). All boat owners must read and follow the guidelines on the Motorized Boat Registration Form. Park your boat and trailer in designated day boat parking lots only, or on your site. Due to milfoil concerns powerboats of any type, including small boats with trolling motors, are not allowed in Huckins Pond.



Trees & Shrubs

Trash

Cutting of trees, saplings, and shrubs are strictly prohobited.

Pyrotechnic Privacy

Please do not cut through other campers' sites on foot, on a bicycle, with a golf cart, or any other means.

Devices

Firecrackers, sparklers, or any other pyrotechnic devices are not permitted. Smoking/Vaping(S)

Bagged household trash only may be disposed of promptly in trash dumpsters located throughout the park. To deter wildlife in the park, never leave trash sitting outside your camping

Boat Slips



It is not permitted inside or within 25 feet of any buildings or at the pool or No fishing from or swimming around the beach and is prohibited by anyone boat slips/dock. Only boat owners and their guest(s) are allowed beyond the gate. under the age of 18. Repeat offenders

will be asked to leave.

Children's Tovs

For the safety of our campers, battery and motor powered toys of any type are not allowed, including selfbalancing hover boards, one wheel boards, and razor scooters. The use of paintball guns is prohibited within the park.

Occupancy

All rental locations must be reserved/occupied by an adult at least 21 years of age

Camp Sites: Rates include 2 Adults & 2 Children. A maximum of 8 people with no more than 4 of them being

Cabins/Cottages: Rates include 2 Adults & 2 Children. A maximum of 6 people with no more than 4 of them being adults. No pets, no smoking, and no vaping allowed.

Bayside Studio: Rate includes 2 adults only. No pets, no smoking, and no vaping allowed.

Speed Limit



Speed limit in the park is 7 mph for all vehicles including golf carts and bicycles, unless otherwise posted. Use caution over the speed bumps throughout the park.

Backflow Preventers

Backflow Preventers have been added to water spigots. A \$100 fine will be assessed to anyone found to have removed the backflow preventer, which is not a pressure reducer.

Pets

Danforth Bay welcomes family pets that are well socialized, friendly, and happy. Only the primary site occupant may bring their furry friends, visitors may not. Pets displaying aggressive or

disruptive behavior must be removed immediately. There is a 2 dog maximum per site. Pet(s) may not be left unattended in your RV, on your site, or in any vehicle, as to disturb other while you are away. If they are a constant barker, please leave them at home. Pets are not

allowed in cabins, cottages, the studio, beaches, pool areas, or any buildings/facilities within the campground. Pets must be on a leash at all times; fencing, kennels, or other containment systems are not allowed. Pets must

be registered with the office. Please see office for info on the Pet Park and Dog Beach. Owner is expected to to resolve any issue with injured parties.

Beach/Pool



There are no lifeguards on duty at any time. There is no swimming allowed after dark. Diving is not permitted into any pool. There is no glass allowed in the pool area. Adults must accompany any child 14 and under at all times. Reserving tables and chairs in not allowed. Please read additional rules posted in swimming areas.

Wildlife



Wildlife and insects are a natural part of the camping experience. Make sure to put food away in sealed containers. Never feed or harass the wildlife.



Drones are not allowed on property
